1. The Mayor announced the first order of business was to consider report from the Zoning Board of Adjustment on application of Hugh Sessions for change of Zone District on Lot No. 5 in Block No. 80 from "G" to "J" in order to permit the operation of Woodworking plant or Cabinet Shop.
2. Barney Franklin, Chairman of the Board was present and reported that the Board had considered the application and recommended that the change in the Zone District be made, as requested.
