On the 9th day of May, 1988, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in a Special Meeting in the Council Chambers of City Hall with the following members thereof, to-wit:

1. Meeting was opened with prayer by City Attorney Bob Flournoy.
2. CANVASS OF MAY 7, 1988 ELECTION RETURNS - CITY OFFICERS ELECTION - COLLECTIVE BARGAINING REFERENDUM

Mayor Garrison stated that the City's Regular Election had been held on May 7, 1988, and announced the results of the Election from the returns forwarded to the City Commission by the Election judges.

The following returns indicating results of the City Election were reviewed for election of Mayor, Commissioners of Wards 2, 4. and 6, and the Collective Bargaining referendum:

Mayor Garrison stated that the above election results had been reviewed and tabulated, which indicated winners of the election to be:

Mayor - Run-Off between Louis Bronaugh and Ed Wareing, Commissioner, Ward 2 - Don Boyd, Commissioner, Ward 4, Bob Bowman and a run-off between Jerry E. Hill and Paul Mayberry in Ward 6. Mayor Garrison stated that the Collective Bargaining referendum had failed.

Motion was made by Commissioner Pat Foley and seconded by Commissioner Danny Roper that the returns have been canvassed and that Don Boyd be declared as the winner for position of Commissioner, Ward 2, Bob Bowman be declared as the winner for position of Commissioner, Ward 4, and that a run-off election will be required to determine the race for Mayor between Louis Bronaugh and Ed Wareing and for the race of Commissioner, Ward 6 between Paul Mayberry and Jerry E. Hill. A unanimous affirmative vote was recorded.

Motion was made by Commissioner Danny Roper and seconded by Commissioner Pat Foley that returns have been canvassed and the Collective Bargaining referendum from the Fire Department has failed by a vote of 1,661 to 1,432. A unanimous affirmative vote was recorded.

3. ORDINANCE - APPROVED - RUN-OFF ELECTION - MAY 21, 1988

Mayor Garrison stated that the Commission would now consider an Ordinance on First and Final Reading setting the date of the Run-off Election.

Mayor Garrison stated that the Ordinance had been prepared setting the date for May 28th. Mayor Garrison stated that since this is Memorial Day week-end he would like to see the date set forward for a better turnout.

Motion was made by Commissioner Percy Simond and seconded by Commissioner Bob Bowman that Run-off Election be set for May 21st with absentee voting beginning Tuesday, May 11 through Tuesday, May 17th, with voting on Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Sunday from 1:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. A unanimous affirmative vote was recorded.

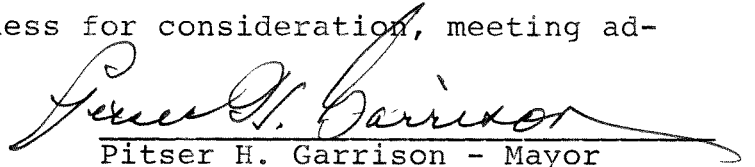
4. RESOLUTION FOR PAT FOLEY - COMMENTS

Commissioner Roper stated that Pat Foley has done an excellent job for the City of Lufkin and that the Commission is indebted to him for his fourteen years of leadership.

Mayor Garrison stated that he had seen a flier printed by the Firefighter's Association in regard to the Collective Bargaining referendum which had been signed by one of the City's election judges.
