MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF  
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF  
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD OCTOBER  
10TH 1938.

Be it remembered that on this the 10th day of October, A.D. 1938, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:

W. M. Glenn,	Mayor,
W. D. Winston, Jr.,	Coms. Ward No. 1,
J. B. Perry,	Coms. Ward No. 3,
C. L. Stine,	City Manager,
Curtis W. Fenley,	City Attorney, and
T. L. Dunn,	City Secretary.

Lewis Hicks, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, and J. E. Jay, Commissioner of Ward No. 4 were absent.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Mr. Clyde Stegall, representing the Ella Stegall Estate was present and requested the City Commission to authorize and order a reduction in the value of Lot No. 12 in Block No. 32, Original Townsite, to \$1,250.00 per year for each year that the value is shown to be \$1,500.00, and also asked that court costs accrued on account of suit being filed be remitted. After consideration of the Matter by the City Commission, and it appearing that the value as shown on the delinquent tax record for all years delinquent are as follows: 1931, \$1,500.00; 1932, \$1,250.00; 1933, \$1,250.00; 1934, \$1,250.00; 1935, \$1,250.00; 1936, \$1,000.00 and 1937, \$1,500.00, it was moved by W. D. Winston and seconded by J. B. Perry that the value be fixed at ~~\$1,250.00~~ for each of the years delinquent, and that the Tax Collector be authorized to collect taxes based on that value. The Mayor put the question and the motion carried unanimously.

All accounts and bills due by the City to various parties, firms and corporations were presented for apyment and it appearing that all of said bills that had been approved for payment by the City Manager, should be paid, on motion duly made and carried, were ordered paid.
