MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEX-
AS, HELD OCTOBER 13TH, 1938.

Be it remembered that on this the 13th day of October, A.D. 1938, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit: W.M.Glenn, Mayor, W.D.Winston, Jr, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, Lewis Hicks, Commissioner Ward No. 2, J. B. Perry, Commissioner Ward No. 3, J. E. Jay, Commissioner Ward No. 4, C. L. Stine, City Manager, Curtis W. Fenley, City Attorney and T.L.Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY NATURAL PERSON OR ASSOCIATION OF NATURAL PERSONS, TRUSTEE, RECEIVER, PARTNERSHIP, CORPORATION, OR THE MANAGER, AGENT, SERVANT, EMPLOYEE OF ANY OF THEM, TO DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, BARTER, OFFER TO BARTER, EXCHANGE, OR OFFER TO EXCHANGE, OR GIVE, WINE, MALT, OR VINOUS LIQUORS, OR ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY RETAIL FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR OFF THE PREMISES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, IN ANGELINA COUNTY, TEXAS, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 12:00 O'CLOCK MIDNIGHT, AND 7:00 O'CLOCK A.M., OF ANY DAY; AND REGULATING AND DESIGNATING PLACES WHERE WINE, MALT OR VINOUS LIQUORS AND BEER MAY BE SOLD WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, PRESCRIBING A PENALTY, SAVING CLAUSE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY" was introduced for passage and approval.

J.B.Perry made a motion that said ordinance be read to the City Commission and that it be passed and approved as emergency ordinance. W. D. Winston seconded the motion. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion. "AYES"- W.M.Glenn, W.D.Winston, Jr. Lewis Hicks, J.B.Perry and J.E.Jay. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved as emergency ordinance. (See another page of these minutes for a record of the Ordinance.)

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, LEVYING AN ANNUAL LICENSE UPON ALL PERSONS WHO MANUFACTURE OR BREW FOR THE PURPOSES OF SALE, OR TO DISTRIBUTE OR SELL ANY BEER, OR TO POSSESS ANY BEER FOR THE PURPOSE OF SALE WITHIN THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, AND DEFINING THE WORD "PERSON", PRESCRIBING A PENALTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY" was introduced for passage and approval

as an emergency ordinance. J.B.Perry made a motion that said ordinance be read to the City Commission and that it be passed and approved as an emergency ordinance. Lewis Hicks seconded the motion. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion. "AYES"- W.M.Glenn, W.D.Winston, Jr. Lewis Hicks, J.B.Perry and J.E. Jay. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved as an emergency ordinance. (See another page of these minutes for a record of the ordinance)
