MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
held December 6th, 1938

Be it remembered that on this 6th day of December, A. D. 1938, there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-Wit:

J. E. Jay, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, was absent.

The following proceedings were had, to wit:

Minutes of all meeting held in November were read and approved.

oOo

A. O. McQueen, et als were present and discussed construction of hangars at Municipal Air Port.

Mr. C. L. Stine, City Manager, was instructed to investigate and report to City Commission his recommendation whether city should build hangar or not.

oOo

A. Motion was made by J. B. Perry, and seconded by W. D. Winston, Jr., that fence be constructed inside Air Port to keep cars and traffic out of Air Port proper, and also to construct Frame Building 14x20 to house Weather Bureau, and instruments and provide office and sleeping quarters for keeper. The Motion carried unanimously.

oOo

A motion was made by J. B. Perry and seconded by W. D. Winston, Jr., that W. C. Book be placed in charge of Air Port, whose duties shall be to supervise maintenance of field (City to furnish working tools, trucks and etc.) his pay to come from Rentals on Seven Air Planes now on the field at Five Dollars (\$5.00) each per month; he to do collecting of rents, and his failure to collect any fees, will be his loss. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Lewis Hicks and seconded by W. D. Winston, Jr., to pass on first reading Ordinance requiring all employees of Food Products and Food Handling Establishments to have Health Certificates. (Ordinance separate page) The motion carried unanimously.

Cont'd.

A Motion was made by J. B. Perry, and seconded by Lewis Hicks to increase City's part of Rent on CCC Camp Site by Seven (\$7.00) per year. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by W. D. Winston, jr., and seconded by J. B. Perry that No Hunting be allowed at City Lake using guns, other than Shot Guns. The Motion carried unanimously.

A. motion was made by W. D. Winston, Jr., and seconded by Lewis Hicks, that resolution be passed amending resolution fixing minimum wage rates. (See another page of these minutes for a record of this resolution) The motion carried unanimously.
