1. J. B. Perry, Walter Trout, members of the School Board present to discuss the proposition of Widening Street in front of the New High School. They requested that the City knock out the Concrete Curb from the Railroad Crossing to Kerr Avenue. The school to Remove Dirt and pay for the Dow Flake (Salt) and the City to put it down for them. it was mutually agreed by school board and City Council to do this.
