A.D. 1939.

BE IT REMEMBERED that on this the 7th day of November, A.D. 1939, there came on and was held a regular meeting of the City Commission in and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the following officers of the city present and presiding to-wit:

The following proceedings were had to-wit:

1. Mayor Glenn read letter from C. C. Reynolds, stating that he did not desire to have a run-off in the race for City Commissioner of Ward No. 3 of the City of Lufkin, Texas, and authorized Mayor and Council to declare G. Etra Barington duly elected as commissioner of Ward 3, of the City of Lufkin, Texas. A motion was made by Lewis Hicks and seconded by J. E. Jay, that G. Etra Barington be declared Commissioner of Ward No. 3. The Mayor put the question to a vote and all voted "Aye"--Noes---None.

2. After the adoption and passage of the above Ordinance, G. Etra Barington was duly inducted into office by having administered to him the official oath of office.

3. Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved.

4. Homer Rogers, H. A. Taylor, and et al were present requesting that City pay for Xmas Street Light Power (Xmas Decoration on Streets) A motion was made by W. D. Winston and seconded by G. Etra Barington that city pay the Power cost on the above. The Mayor put the matter to a vote---All voted "Aye" "Noes"--none.

5. Mr. Rook, of Beaumont, Texas, was present in regard to acquiring Bus Franchise in City of Lufkin Texas, at \$25.00 for each Bus for first year, for next 2 years 50.00 for each Bus, and \$75.00 per Bus for last year. A Motion was made by ^{W. D. Winston, jr.,} J. E. Jay, and seconded by J. E. Jay, that Franchise be granted and to be drawn up by City Atty.

The Mayor put the question to a vote and all voted "AYE"--"Noes"-None.

6. C. L. Stine, City Mgr., explained the details to City council in Regard to WPA Street Marking Project, and was authorized by Council to submit same to WPA office for approval.

7. B. Rolston, County Judge, was present in regard to City paying one-half of the Rent for Office Space for Investigator for WPA in the Feagin Building, same being \$7.50 per month for City's Part, and also 1/2 of the Rent for Office Space for Joe C. Denman, in chg. of Old Age Pension Wk. and etc., and the Rent being \$10.00 per month for the City's part. A Motion was made by J. E. Jay that City pay the \$10.00 per month at First State Bank, The motion was seconded by W. D. Winston. All voted "Aye"--"Noes" None.

8. Accounts and bills due by the City to various parties, firms and Corporations were presented for payment and it appearing that such or said bills as had been properly audited and approved for payment by the City Manager should be paid, on motion duly made and carried were ordered paid.

9. A motion was made by W. D. Winston and seconded by Lewis Hicks that Mayor be authorized to execute deed in exchange for street R/W to Kate Glover (63x60). All voted "Aye"--"Noes"--none.

10. A Motion was made by W. D. Winston, and seconded by G. Stra Barington that the Salary of Finis Whisenant be boosted from \$125.00 to \$140.00 per month. The Mayor put the question to vote, and all voted "Aye". "Noes" None.

11. A discussion concerning the property of Albert Johnson, in The Townsend Addition to the City of Lufkin, Texas, came up for discussion, and since same had been investigated it was moved by W. D. Winston that Valuation be placed at \$500.00 prior to and including the year A.D. 1939. The motion was seconded by Lewis Hicks. All voted "Aye" "Noes-None.
