Be it remembered that on this the 9th day of January, A.D. 1939, there was begun and holden a Call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:

accounts and bills due by the City to various parties, firms and corporations were presented for payment, and it appearing that such of said accounts and bills as had been properly audited and approved for payment by the City Manager should be paid, on motion duly made and carried same were allowed and oredered paid.

The matter of the unsanitary condition of the buildings, at least part of them, located on Hernden Street in Block No. 79, was discussed by the City Commission and it appearing that an effort had been made to clear up the unsanitary condition by having the property ewner or ewners to connect such premises to the sanitary sewer system of the City, but that all efforts so far had met with complete failure, it was ordered that the proper officers of the City proceed at once to abate the missance created by the unsanitary condition as aforesaid by closing up those places that, upon inspection, are found to be unsanitary.

There being no further business to come before the meeting on motion duly made and carried, it adjourned.
