Purpose of the meeting was to discuss the matter of securing the necessary right-of-way over or through property of R. V. Welch, Jr, for a street, which street would connect to a Sate Highway leading to the new Paper Mill site. The said R. V. Welch, Jr. having refused to donate the necessary right of way negotiations were had with him and he final made a proposition that the necessary right-of-way would be deeded to the City in consideration of the payment to him the sum of \$500.00, cash. The City Commission carefully considered the matter and all evidence and information obtained to date indicted that his property, the portion to be used for street purposes was worth that amount, hence it was moved by W. D. Winstoh, Jr. and seconed by J. E. Jay, that if it is finally determined that the property was necessary for the purposes as aforesaid, that the City pay to the said R. V. Welch the said sum of \$500.00, cash for the right-Off-way needed. The Mayor put the question and the motion carried unanimously.
