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MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE
CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEX-
AS, HELD JULY 7th, A. D. 1939.

Be it remembered that on this the 7th day of July, A.D. 1939, there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City, with the following officers of the City present and presiding, to-wit:

Cecil Massingill, City Secretary, was absent - on vacation.

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The following proceedings were had, to-wit:

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Bills and accounts due by the City to various parties, firms and corporations were presented to the City Commission for payment, and it appearing that such of said bills as had been properly audited and approved by the City Manager should be paid, on motion duly made and carried were ordered paid.

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An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT AND PUNISH INTERFERENCE WITH MOLESTATION OR DISTURBANCE OF MECHANICS AND LABORERS IN THE PURSUIT OF THEIR WORK OR VOCATION, BY THREATS, INTIMIDATION, SOLICITATION OR OTHERWISE, AND TO PROHIBIT AND PUNISH THE ASSEMBLANCE OF GROUPS WITHOUT AUTHORITY OF LAW IN PUBLIC PLACES, STREETS AND HIGHWAYS IN THE CITY OF LUFKIN FOR THE PURPOSE OF INTERFERENCE WITH, MOLESTATION OR DISTURBANCE OF SUCH MECHANICS OR LABORERS IN THE PURSUIT OF THEIR WORK OR VOCATION OR IN GOING TO OR RETURNING FROM THEIR PLACES OF WORK AND VOCATION BY THREATS, INTIMIDATIONS, SOLICITATIONS OR OTHERWISE, AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF"

was introduced for passage and approval as an emergency ordinance. The various sections of the Ordinance were discussed; the merits of same were given due consideration, after which it was moved by W. D. Winston, Jr. that said ordinance be read to the City Commission and that it be passed and approved as an emergency ordinance as provided by Special Charter of the City of Lufkin and the Laws of the State of Texas; said motion was seconded by Lewis Hicks. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "AYES"- W. D. Winston, Jr., Lewis Hicks and R. C. Arnett. "NOES"- W. M. Glenn and J. E. Jay. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved, and same shall be in force and effective immediately after publication as provided by the Special Charter of the City of Lufkin (See another page for Ordinance)

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An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF AN ORDINANCE PASSED AND APPROVED ON SECOND READING ON THE 5TH DAY OF JULY, 1939, BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, AND ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION IN AND FOR THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR A. D. 1939"

was introduced for passage and approval on first reading. Lewis Hicks made a motion that said ordinance be placed on first reading and that it be passed and approved on first reading: J. E. Jay seconded the motion. The Mayor put the question and the following is the recorded vote on the motion: "AYES"- W. M. Glenn, W. D. Winston, Jr. Lewis Hicks, R.C. Arnett and J. E. Jay. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved on first reading.

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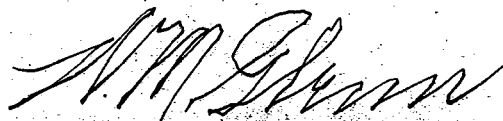
There came up for discussion and consideration the matter of securing from the United Gas Corporation a financial statement showing receipts and disbursements as effecting the Lufkin Franchise only for their last fiscal year; letting such statement show as much detail as possible that will reflect the total investment in Lufkin. The purpose of such statement to be for information to the City Commission in order that they may determine if the rate now being charged in Lufkin is excessive or not. J. E. Jay made a motion that the Mayor be authorized to make official request of the United Gas Corporation to furnish the statement as outlined in the first part of this paragraph. The motion was seconded by R. C. Arnett. The question was put by the mayor and the following is the recorded vote on same: "Ayes"- W. M. Glenn, W. D. Winston, Jr., Lewis Hicks, R. C. Arnett and J. E. Jay. "NOES"- None. Whereupon the mayor declared the motion carried.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried, it adjourned.

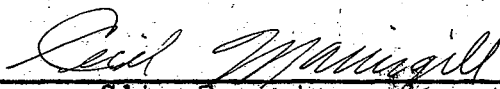
