MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS HELD OCTOBER 14, 1940
AT 3:00 P. M.

① The City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas convened in special meeting at the regular meeting place on October 14, 1940 at 3:00 p.m. with the following members present:

and the following absent: R. E. Melvin, Commissioner, Ward No. 2. when the following business was had:

1. K. Morris appeared requesting approval of his application for a filling station to be located near the city limits on Highway 69 north. Upon motion of W. D. Winston, Jr., seconded by G. E. Barington, the application was approved subject to the presentment by Mr. Morris of plans and specifications and his compliance with all ordinances of the City of Lufkin.

2. The Zoning Commission having previously submitted its final report to the Council, and the Council having held its public hearings on the proposed zoning ordinance and map, upon motion of W. D. Winston, Jr., seconded by G. E. Barington, the map as presented to the Council by the Zoning Commission and the ordinance as prepared by them were approved and the City Manager and City Attorney were instructed to take the necessary steps to get them preparation for publication, but final action on the passage of the ordinance was not taken at this time.

3. Upon motion of W. D. Winston, Jr. Seconded by G. E. Barington, Townsend Alley was designated to be paved 24 feet wide instead of 20 feet wide, and curbing was added to the original plans, this making the costs to the property owners about \$1.30 per front foot.


