- I. The purpose of this meeting was to meet with Mr. Curtis Morris of the East Texas Chamber of Commerce and to discuss the budget of the City of Lufkin for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1941.
- 2 Mr. Morris recommended that the City install a sewer charge of \$1.00 per month instead of 50¢ per month as is the present practice of the city. He recommended that the City begin charging for garbage removal as was being done in several other cities, the charge to be based upon a reasonable classification of the amount of garbage usually removed.
  - 3. The budget was gone into, item by item and was analized.
- 4. Mr. Morris called attention to the heavy indebtedness of the City and warned against increasing it by additional bond issues for at least 5 years.
- 5. There being no further business to come before the meeting, the meeting was, upon motion duly made and carried, adjourned.
