

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD JULY 1,
1941 AT 7:30 P. M.

On this the 1st day of July, A. D. 1941, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas convened in Regular session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. The minutes of all meetings held during the month of June were read, approved and adopted.
2. An ordinance ordering the paving of West Grove Street from the east line of Bynum Street to the west line of Bledsoe Street was introduced for passage.
3. An ordinance ordering the paving of West Grove Street from the east line of Bledsoe Street to the east line of Kelley Street was introduced for passage.
4. An ordinance ordering the paving of Bledsoe Street from the south line of Persimmon Avenue to the south line of California Blvd. was introduced for passage.
5. An ordinance ordering the paving of Bledsoe Street from the south line of Grove Avenue to the south line of Persimmon Street was introduced for passage.
6. The proceedings had on the above four ordinances will be found immediately following these minutes, said ordinances all being passed on first, second and final reading.
7. Mrs. Happy Daniels appeared and requested permission to build a filling station on South First Street and Menefee Street in a district for one family residences. The Mayor requested the Zoning Committee be called to meet Wednesday morning at 10:00 o'clock to go into this matters.
8. Mr. J. C. Griffin requested the Council to provide water for his property adjacent to Highway 103. He was told that water

would be furnished when he had several houses erected which would use water services, but no definite action was taken.

Howard Marrell offered to sell his swimming pool and one acre of land to the City of \$4,350.00 or with 3 acres of land for \$6,500.00. No action was taken.

Mr. George Largent requested an adjustment of the tax values on his property for delinquent years. It appearing to the Council that values for the years on which the taxes were delinquent were excessive, passed a resolution upon motion of Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by W. A. Green, fixing his valuation at \$650.00 for delinquent years.

Mr. J. D. Jauthen and Mr. J. Howell presented an insurance plan for the City. Several changes were requested and they were invited to appear at another meeting with the plan as amended for further consideration.

Upon motion of R. E. Melvin, seconded by W. A. Green, all commissioners present voting "Yea", the balance due Koch & Fowler and Reynolds & Sutton on completed streets was ordered paid.


At a meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Dallas, Texas, held on the 1st day of July, 1941, the following resolution was adopted:




