

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD NOVEMBER 10
1941 AT 7:30 P. M.

On this the 10th day of November, A. D. 1941, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas convened in special session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

being present, and the following absent: R. E. MELVIN and W. A. GREEN, Commissioners, constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. All bills for the previous month were presented, approved and ordered paid. Motion for this action was made by Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by J. E. Jay.

2. Mr. Beaumier, of the Chamber of Commerce, was present and requested the City to pay for the cost of Christmas Street Lights. On motion of Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by J. E. Jay the city agreed to pay for the lights, the lights to be used from December 1st to January 1st.

3. Harry Abram appeared and told the Council that he had planned to take the top story off their building and rebuild the front and rear, leaving it one story in height in a safe condition in so far as the public is concerned.

4. Upon motion of Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by J. R. Jay, condemnation proceedings on the Pate and Denman Buildings were held up

pending repairing of both, this work to begin on or before January 10, 1942.

Hiram Rolston and George Jones appeared with reference to the reinstatement of George Jones' chauffer's license. The matter was deferred to a later meeting.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was, upon motion duly made and seconded, adjourned.
