5 Upon motion of W. D. Winston, seconded by ". E. Meliin, the Vity Vecretary was ordered to publish the required notice of a public hearing upon the recommendations of the Zoning Committee that the ordinance be amended so as to change the property on both sides of North First Street between Laurel and Jack Streets so that such property would be classified as local retail and so as to change block 4 of the kimmey Addition from multi-family to industrial. All commissioners present voted YEA.

6 Bids were opened from Henderson-Medford Mobor Company, Angelina Chevrolet Company, Berry Motor Company and Crouch Truck & Implement Company for a garbage truck. Upon motion of W. D.
