

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD MARCH 4,
1941 AT 7:30 P. M.

On this the 4th day of March, A. D. 1941, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas convened in regular session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

being present, and the following absent: COMMISSIONER J. E. JAY, constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. The minutes of all meetings held during February were read and approved.

2. Mr. Wilson and Mr. Castleberry appeared in the interest of securing sewerage service for Oakgrove and Oakgrove Place Additions. Upon motion of G. E. Barington, seconded by R. E. Melvin, the City Manager was authorized to arrange for the installation of a lift pump and two sewer lines to service the above named additions.

3. Upon motion of G. E. Barington, seconded by W. D. Winston, Jr., the taxi permits of R. C. Deal were transferred to W. F. Jones.

4. An ordinance ^{requesting liquefied gas (M.S.A.)} was introduced and upon motion of R. E. Melvin, seconded by W. D. Winston, Jr., the ordinance was placed upon and passed first reading, and carried by the following vote:

Carried, and placed upon second reading.

Upon motion of G. E. Barington, seconded by R. E. Melvin, the ordinance was placed upon and passed second and final reading,

and carried by the following vote:

NAY: NONE.

The mayor then declared the ordinance passed on second and final reading.

The ordinance will be found immediately following these minutes.

5 Upon motion of W. D. Winston, seconded by R. E. Melvin, the City Secretary was ordered to publish the required notice of a public hearing upon the recommendations of the Zoning Committee that the ordinance be amended so as to change the property on both sides of North First Street between Laurel and Jack Streets so that such property would be classified as local retail and so as to change block 4 of the Kimmey Addition from multi-family to industrial. All commissioners present voted YEA.

6 Bids were opened from Henderson-Medford Motor Company, Angelina Chevrolet Company, Berry Motor Company and Crouch Truck & Implement Company for a garbage truck. Upon motion of W. D. Winston, Jr., seconded by G. E. Barington, the City Manager was authorized to buy the truck he thinks best suited for the job. All Commissioners present voted YEA.

7 Upon motion of R. E. Melvin, seconded by W. D. Winston, Jr., all Commissioners present voting YEA, the City Manager was authorized to purchase a second hand ditching machine for \$1600.00.

8 Upon motion of W. D. Winston, Jr., seconded by G. E. Barington, all commissioners present voting YEA, it was decided to assist in the building of an NYA office building on City property at a cost not to exceed \$400.00.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was upon motion duly made and carried, adjourned.
