constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:


1. The accounts for the month of March were allowed and ordered paid, all commissioners presenting voting "Yea".

3. C. D. Lowery, operator of Brownie's Taxi appeared and told the Council he had been unable to find a substantial insurance company to insure his taxis and requested an extension of time and if possible an amendment of the ordinance.
