
being present, and the following absent: W. A. GREEN,
constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Mr. V. G. Koch and Mr. J. M. York of the Highway Department were present in connection with the proposed location of Highway 59 through the City. Mr. Koch presented the proposition of the Highway Department which required the City to do all the necessary work and right-of-way, including curb, gutter, grading and drainage structures and required the Highway Department to lay the concrete on the 56 foot highway through the City from north to south. The commission was of the opinion that this would entail too much expense on the part of the City and it was decided to send a delegation to Austin for a conference with Mr. Huffman and Mr. Geer in an effort to secure a greater contribution on the part of the Highway Department.

2. No action was taken toward accepting the proposition as submitted by the Highway Department and further consideration of the matter was postponed until such time as the officials in Austin could be contacted.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was, upon motion duly made and carried, adjourned.
