1. Mayor Glenn announced the purpose of the meeting was for
having public hearing on the City Budget for the fiscal year
1942-43, notice of which was published in the Lufkin Daily
News on July 19th, 26th and August 3rd.

2. Mr. W. R. Beaumier and Mr. W. D. Winston, Jr. were present
