AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE TAXES TO BE LEVIED, ASSESSED, AND COLLECTED BY THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, LEVYING THE SAME FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1942 - 1943 AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER UNTIL OTHERWISE PROVIDED, APPROPRIATING 87½¢ OF EACH \$100.00 VALUATION ON ALL PROPERTY, REAL, PERSONAL, AND MIXED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING AND DEFRAYING THE CURRENT AND GENERAL EXPENSES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING 87½¢ OF EACH \$100.00 VALUATION ON ALL PROPERTY, REAL, PERSONAL AND MIXED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE INTEREST AND CREATING A SINKING FUND TO REDEEM THE OUTSTANDING BONDS OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE TAXES TO BE LEVIED, ASSESSED AND COLLECTED BY THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, LEVYING THE SAME FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1942 - 1943 AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER UNTIL OTHERWISE PROVIDED, APPROPRIATING 87½¢ OF EACH \$100.00 VALUATION ON ALL PROPERTY, REAL, PERSONAL AND MIXED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING AND DEFrayING THE CURRENT AND GENERAL EXPENSES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, APPROPRIATING 87½¢ OF EACH \$100.00 VALUATION ON ALL PROPERTY, REAL, PERSONAL AND MIXED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE INTEREST AND CREATING A SINKING FUND TO REDEEM THE OUTSTANDING BONDS OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby levied, to be assessed and collected in current money of the United States of American, for the use of the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the fiscal year 1942 - 1943, and for each year thereafter until it be otherwise provided and ordained, an annual direct ad-valorem tax of ONE AND SEVENTY-FIVE/ONE HUNDREDTH (\$1.75) DOLLARS on every ONE HUNDRED DOLLAR (\$100.00) of value thereof on all property, real, personal and mixed, within the City of Lufkin, Texas upon which a tax is authorized by Law and the Charter of said City to be levied by the City of Lufkin, Texas.

SECTION 2. That there is hereby levied, to be assessed and collected in current money of the United States of American, for the use of the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the fiscal year 1942 - 1943, and for each year thereafter until it be otherwise provided and ordained, on all occupation pursued in the City of Lufkin, Texas, upon which an occupation or license tax is authorized by the Laws of the State of Texas to be levied, assessed, and collected, a tax of one-half (1/2) of the State Occupation and/or License Tax as levied by the State of Texas, as shown by the Laws and Constitution of the State of Texas applicable thereto, which said Laws are made a part hereof as if fully written herein for all purposes, and the failure to enumerate said occupation and license shall in no degree or manner defeat the collection of said taxes.

SECTION 3. That the taxes levied, to be assessed and collected as set out above shall be and they are hereby appropriated for the following purposes, and no other:

(A) Eighty-seven and one-half (87½¢) cents of each \$1.00 of such taxes collected for the purpose of paying and defraying the current and general expenses of the Government of the City of Lufkin, Texas. Said amount or amounts shall be placed in a fund to be known as the GENERAL FUND and shall be known and designated as General Fund Taxes.

(B) Eighty-seven and one-half (87½¢) cents of each \$1.00 of such taxes collected for the purpose of paying the interest and creating a sinking fund to redeem the outstanding bonds of the City of Lufkin, Texas. Said amount or amounts shall be placed in a fund to be known as the INTEREST & SINKING FUND and shall be known and designated as INTEREST AND SINKING FUND TAXES.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS for the Fiscal Year ended MARCH 31, 1943, AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Laws of the State of Texas and the Charter of the City of Lufkin, the City Manager of said City prepared and submitted to the City Commission of said City, a proposed budget for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1943; and,

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was had on the 13th day of August, A. D. 1942, pursuant to Notice published in the Lufkin Daily News, a daily newspaper published in Lufkin, Angelina County, Texas, as shown in the affidavit of the Publisher thereof which accompanies this Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the City Commission, at said Public Hearing, the proposed was discussed and sufficient time was given to hearing protests and objections, oral or written, to items in the budget and to omissions therefrom:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Budget of the City of Lufkin, Texas, for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1943, as the same has been prepared and submitted to the Commission by the City Manager, be, and the same is hereby APPROVED AND ADOPTED.

SECTION 2. That a copy of said Budget shall be filed with the County Clerk of Angelina County, Texas, and with the State Comptroller at Austin, Travis County, Texas.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED NINETY-NINE AND 94/100 (\$3,599.94) DOLLARS OUT OF THE GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDED MARCH 31, 1943, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ADDITIONAL EARNINGS FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN FOR THE LAST SEVEN (7) MONTHS OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDED MARCH 31, 1943; APPROVING AND ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF EMERGENCY EARNINGS AND BONUSES, AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the high cost of living, occasioned by the State of War in which our Nation now finds itself has made it impossible for some of the employees of the City of Lufkin to provide the everyday necessities of life for themselves and their families out of their regular and budgeted earnings; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager of the City of Lufkin has prepared a Schedule of Emergency Earnings and Bonuses and recommended that it be applied for the last seven (7) months of the Fiscal Year Ended March 31, 1943, on the following basis:

<u>SALARY BRACKET</u>	<u>EMERGENCY EARNINGS</u>
\$300.00--\$125.00 Per Mo.	NONE
\$124.99--\$100.00 Per Mo.	5% Increase
Below \$100.00	10% Increase

On or about December 23, 1942, a Bonus equal to 10% of the average monthly earnings of **ALL** employees should be paid, based upon the earnings for the previous six (6) months.

On or about March 10, 1943, a Bonus equal to 10% of the average monthly earnings of **ALL** Employees should be paid, based upon the earnings for the previous six (6) months.

The total amount involved in this Emergency Earnings and Bonus Schedule shall be THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED NINETY-NINE AND 94/100 (\$3,599.94) DOLLARS, and

WHEREAS, said Schedule of Emergency Earnings and Bonuses has been reviewed and considered by the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, at a meeting called for that purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the above Schedule of Emergency Earnings and Bonuses be, and the same is hereby approved and established.

SECTION 2. That there is hereby appropriated, out of the General Fund of the City of Lufkin, Texas, the sum of THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED NINETY-NINE AND 94/100 (\$3,599.94) DOLLARS for the sole and only purpose of paying the said Emergency Earnings and Bonuses set out in said Schedule.

SECTION 3. That the payment of the Emergency Earnings and Bonuses set out in said Schedule shall be made separate and apart from the regular budgeted earnings of the employees affected.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall be in force and take effect in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Lufkin, in such cases made and provided.
