On this the 6th day of January, A. D. 1941², the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas convened in Regular session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. All minutes held during the month of December, 1941 were read, approved and adopted.

2. Curtis Fenley, tax attorney for the County, appeared before the Commission and requested that the City appoint a board of adjustment with full powers in order that the great amount of delinquent taxes on unproductive and low priced land be adjusted and placed in current form so as to increase tax revenue. He stated that the County and School had appointed such boards.

3. After a full discussion, upon motion of Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by J. E. Jay, with all commissioners present voting "Y#A", the following resolution was adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS:

4. That J. W. Lewis, tax assessor and collector, and Ned Shands, Jr., city attorney, and their successors in office, be, and they are hereby appointed as a Board of Adjustment with full authority to make adjustments and settlements for the City in tax matters relating to valuations of all delinquent taxes.

5. Upon motion of Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by R. E. Melvin, the bills for the month of December were approved and ordered paid.

6. Upon motion of Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by R. E. Melvin, the salary of Mrs. Murray was increased from \$37.50 to \$50.00 per month, this being the city's part for the County Welfare Nurse's salary.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was, upon motion duly made and carried, adjourned.
