

Superior Texas June 2nd 1891

Council of the town of
Lufkin met in Mayor's
office in regular session
June 2nd. Mayor Smith in the
Chair. J. Kerr, J. C. McPherson,
J. P. W. - Aldermen present.
Supt. Accounts being in
great business before the
Council it was ordered
to pay J. F. McCarter \$4.00
for holding elections.
J. G. Mann was allowed \$2.00
for the same purpose.
R. S. Powell was allowed
the sum of \$2.00 in consid-
eration of his services
as an Elections Clerk.
It was further ordered
that E. J. Maitland, J. Kerr,
J. C. McPherson, J. P. W. be all
paid the sum of \$2.00

for services as Aldermen
the same amt to the
Mayor J. M. Smith - for
meeting May 5th

Ordered by the Town Council
of the town of Suffolk
that Arts 1st Chap III. shall be
his hereby quoad as
to read as follows:

That all trials & proceedings had
before the Mayor Court the
rule of procedure prescribed
for County or Justice of the
Peace shall govern, and the
Mayor shall have the same
powers that are vested in
a Justice of the Peace when
the fine or amount in
controversy shall not exceed
the sum Two Hundred dollars
unless otherwise
provided in these ordinances
And the general laws of the
State of Texas.
