

MINUTES OF RECESSED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD FEBRUARY 10,  
1942 AT 10:00 A. M.

constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Messrs Woodruff, Graves, and Melton, with the W.P.A. and Messrs. Huff and Baird of Reynolds & Sutton, and Mr. Fowler of Koch & Fowler were present for a discussion of the second paving unit.

2. Work was authorized to begin on February 12th. The project was fully discussed and Mr. Stine request that he would like to have at least 30 days notice in advance of the paving of each street in order to install water and sewer connections.


3. Upon motion of Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by R.E. Melvin, the bills for the month of January were approved and ordered paid.


4. Upon motion of R. E. Melvin, seconded by Cary C. Trevathan, the voucher covering final payment to Koch & Fowler for services on the first paving unit was <sup>ordered</sup> paid when corrected.

There being no further business, the meeting was, upon motion duly made and seconded, recessed until February 12, 1942 at 2:00 p.m.
