"Minutes of all meetings held during the month of October were read and regularly approved.

2. E. J. Conn addressed the Commission, requesting the reinstatement of R.C. Chancey as Chief of Police and Mayor Glenn read a letter from Mr. Chancey addressed to the City Commission, making application for re-instatement as Chief.

Motion was made by R. E. Melvin that Mr. Chancey be reinstated but there was no second.

Motion was made by Arthur Temple, Jr., second by Jas. A. Abney that Mr. Chancey be offered a place as policeman on the force. The Mayor called for vote and Arthur Temple, Jr., B. F. Milligan and Jas. A. Abney voted yea, R.E. Melvin voted nay. The Mayor declared the motion carried.

JA. O. McQueen appeared in the interest of J.W.Marshall, requesting that he be given further time in which to dispose of his building on the air port property.

On motion of Arthur Temple, Jr., second by B.F. Milligan all members voting yea, Mr. Marshall was given until December 31st 1943 to dispose of his building and the City Secretary was instructed to notify him to that effect by letter.

7 Motion was made by R.E.Melvin, second by Jas.A.Abney approving renewal of lease on the Jones Lake property to J.D.Mertin for another year on the same terms as in the lease expiring November 5th 1943. The motion carried by all members voting yea.

Nothing further was offered for attention and the meeting was adjourned.
