constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Also in attendance were Mr. D. W. Thompson and Mr. J. B. Perry representing the Angelina County Y.M.C.A.
2. Mayor Glenn announced the purpose of the meeting was to make or discuss plans for operating the Community Center Building in the City Park.
3. Mr. Thompson addressed the Commission and stated that the Y.M.C.A. Board had agreed to turn the building over to the City with the understanding that the Y.M.C.A. have office space in the building and also have the privilege of using such part of the building and at such times as may be agreed upon by the committee in charge, for it's meetings or activities.
4. Mr. Thompson stated the Y.M.C.A. Board had passed a ^{formal}/resolution in a recent meeting in which these matters were confirmed and that he would furnish the City Manager with a copy of the resolution.
5. Motion was made by Jas A. Abney and seconded by B.F. Milligan that the building be accepted on the terms as outlined.
The motion was carried by all members voting yea.
