2. Mr. Kelley stated the contract with J. W. Marshall for the Municipal Air Port had expired and that Mr. Marshall was here in the interest of renewing the contract.

5. Mr. Marshall stated the program of the Government had been changed and that he had been unable to get another contract for training pilots, after completing two, but that he would like to continue to keep the field open and operate it, but without the performance bond requirement.

Mr. McQueen stated th that he thought Mr. Marshall should be considered and that the field should be kept open, especially for the present. Maptain Hataway expressed the opinion that provision would be for further training of pilots again in the near future.

Motion was made by R.E.Melvin, second by B.F.Milligan and carried by all commissioners voting yea that Mr. Marshall's contract be extended thirty days and in the meantime a new contract be drawn up revising the lease, for consideration at a meeting with Mr. Marshall to be held about February 10th.
