3. Motion was made by Jas. A. Abney, second by B. F. Milligan that the bills be approved and paid and carried by all members voting yea.
4. Application of C. A. Pate <sup>For</sup> breaking the curb and making two driveways on ~~East~~ <sup>Dexter</sup> ~~Dexter~~ <sup>avenue</sup> Avenue in the 100 Block leading to his property in Block 9 was presented and approval recommended by Mr. Kelley.
5. Motion was made by Jas. A. Abney, seconded by Arthur Temple, Jr. that the driveways be permitted carried by all members voting yea.
