

MINUTES OF Called MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD June 4th  
1943 AT 3:00 P M:

On this the 4th day of June, A. D. 1943,  
the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in

constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Also present were Mr. Carroll, Mr. Curry and Mr. Cain,  
representing the United Gas Corporation.

2. The Mayor called on these representatives of the Gas  
company for such information as they might have for the  
commission in connection with the proposed change in rates  
for natural gas within the City.

3. The matter was discussed  
thoroughly, after which a motion was made by Arthur Temple, Jr.  
second by R. E. Melvin and carried by all members voting yea,  
passing on second and final reading the ordinance that was  
passed May 18th 1943 on first reading, and which repealed an  
ordinance passed in April 1940 for regulating rates for gas.


4. Motion was then made by Jas. A. Abney, second by B. F. Milligan  
and carried by all members voting yea, accepting a revised  
schedule of rates for Natural Gas to Commercial and Residential  
users within the City, copy of which is filed with these minutes.

5. Report of A. E. Mantooth, Judson Coward, and K. Morgan on  
question of land in Chestnut street claimed by Hubbard & Melton  
was read in which they recommend the City pay Hubbard & Melton  
\$25.00 for the land now being used for street purposes.

6. Motion was made by Jas. A. Abney, second by Arthur Temple, Jr.  
that the City pay Hubbard & Melton \$25.00 for the land on re-  
ceipt from them of a deed to same approved by the City Attorney.

7. Nothing further was presented for attention and the meeting  
was adjourned.
