

MINUTES OF CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD DECEMBER 18, 1945
AT 3:00 P. M.

On this the 18 day of December, A. D., 1945, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in a called session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

being present, and none absent, thus constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Mrs. Royce White was present and asked if the City Commission would take some action in regards to getting a gas line extension on Myrna Street. She was told by the City Attorney that it was his opinion that if all the citizens living on Myrna Street who wanted gas service would go together to the Gas Co., and make application for this service, that the Gas Co., would feel justified in making this extension. *(extension)*

2. There were no objections to the proposed Zoning Changes as advertised for public hearing at this meeting and upon motion of J. A. Abney and seconded by E. A. Gibbs, the changes were passed on second and final reading *by* unanimous vote.

3. Upon recommendation of the Zoning Board, an application from C. L. Brown requesting that a portion of Zone "F" be changed to "G" was read. Motion was made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by E. F. Milligan that the application be passed on first reading and advertised for public hearing at the regular meeting to be held in January. The motion was carried unanimously.

No further business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
