constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted.

1. Mayor announced the meeting was for public hearing on application for change of Zone District from E to F on Lot 4 Block 4 of Kimney Addition as advertised in the Lufkin Daily News on March 11, 1945. Mr. S. N. Berry stated that he wished the Zone District changed to permit the grocery store as it would be a benefit to him, and to the town.
2. T. J. Melton appeared and called attention to the building now under construction was in violation of the Ordinance and was assured the ordinance would be enforced. After thorough discussion, motion was made by J. A. Abney, second by Arthur Temple, Jr., and carried by unanimous vote approving change from E. to F. as requested.

No further business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
