constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:  
1 August Bills in the amount of \$23,348.35, were reviewed and upon motion  
of D. M. Thrash and seconded by B. F. Milligan were ordered paid.  
2 The Typhus Control Program was discussed and it was decided to  
continue the Program with strict enforcement, of the ordinance.

3 Other subjects brought up for discussion were bi-monthly payroll for  
employees who are now on the weekly payroll, and the purchase of flowers  
for City employees in case of sickness or death, with City Funds. It  
was decided that beginning October 1, 1946, all City payrolls will be  
on the bi-monthly basis, and that in the future, no City funds will be  
spent for flowers.

No further business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
