Other subjects brought up for discussion were bi-monthly payroll for employees who are now on the weekly payroll, and the purchase of flowers for City employees in case of sickness or death, with City Funds. It was decided that beginning October 1, 1946, all City payrolls will be on the bi-monthly basis, and that in the future, ho City funds will be spent for flowers.
No further business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
