

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD ON APRIL 8, 1946

On this, the 8th. day of April, 1946, A. D., the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in a called session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof to-wit:

being present, with none absent; thus, constituting a quorum, when the following business was transacted:

1. L. C. Martin and D. M. Thrash were installed and took Oath of Office for Commissioner for the next two years.

2. March bills in the amount of \$4,200.37, were examined and upon motion of E. A. Gibbs and seconded by B. F. Milligan, were ordered paid by unanimous vote.

3. A form of deed for right of way of proposed highways was presented for approval. Upon examination of the deed form, and O. K. by the City Attorney, it was moved by B. F. Milligan and seconded by L. C. Martin, that the form be adopted. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

4. An amendment to the Taxi Cab Ordinance was passed on first reading on motion of E. A. Gibbs and seconded by B. F. Milligan and all members voting yea.

5. Mr. Lewis reported that he had made an investigation on the drainage in the South part of Town in accordance with a request from people living outside the City Limits on Hurricane Creek, and that it was his opinion that if the creek was straightened that it would rush the water down the creek and would cause an overflow further out. He stated that two breaks had been found in the sewer line in that vicinity and that they had been repaired.

6. The following subjects were discussed without official action being taken: Paving on Third street; Reserved Parking Space; Parking Meters; Street Widening; and Curbs, Butane Gas Ordinance, Rat Ordinance and Cashing of War Bonds.

7. A report on the progress of converting Jones Lake Park into a park for the colored was made by Mr. Lewis and official date for opening was set for April 15, 1946.

8. The following Zoning change applications were read: Morris Davis portion of "A" to "C"; Henry Thompson portion of "E" to "F" and Mrs Rose Moss portion of "B" to "F". It was moved by B. F. Milligan and seconded by D. M. Thrash that the applications be advertised for public hearing and that the date be set for April 16, 1946, at 3: P. M. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

No further business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
