A.Bids were received from Rodger Smith in the amount of \$11,272.38 and from T. E. Bresner in the amount of \$11,729.90. No other bids were received. The bids were discussed after which it was moved by E. A. Gibbs and seconded by B. F. Milligan to award the contract to the low bidder, Rodger Smith, in the amount of \$11,272.38. The motion carried by unanimous vote of yea.

3. A report of progress in securing right-of-way for Highway 59 from E. W. Leach, was read by Mr. Lewis.

4 A letter from B.F. Hoffman in regards to the garbage ordinance was read. Other subjects discussed were: taxation, Library Lease and Rail Road Grade Crossings.

No further business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
