

MINUTES OF called MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD July 9  
1946 AT 3:30 P. M.

On this the 9 day of July, A. D. 1946,  
the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas convened in

constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Visitors to the meeting were: Messrs. Glenn Burgess, D. W. Thompson, Dexter Satterwhite of the Air Port Advisory Board, and Mr. Carter of Carter & Burgess Engineers.

2. It was pointed out by Mr. Thompson that in order to secure stops for Lufkin on the Major Airlines, that it would be necessary to improve the air port and that it was the Advisory Board's recommendation that plans and specifications be prepared. Mr. Carter stated that his Firm would make application for Federal Aid for the project free of charge. It was then moved by L. C. Martin and seconded by B. F. Milligan, to authorize Mr. Carter to make application for Federal Aid provided no charge would be made to the City. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

3. Henry Box was present and asked that the Commission re-consider his application to change the Zone classification on his home, in order to permit him to operate a Grocery business. He was told that it was the intention of the City to reroute Highway 69, through the City and that it would take part of his property and that it would be better for him to secure another location.

4. The following Zone changes were made after being previously approved and advertised for public hearing at this meeting: Lot 16 and 17, Block 2, Southland Addition from A to B District. Lot 11 and 12, Block 74, Original Townsite from G to H district. Lot 6, Block 18, Lufkin Investment and Loan addition from E to F. Changes were made upon motion of B. F. Milligan and seconded by L. C. Martin and carried by unanimous vote.

5. June bills in the amount of \$8484.25 were reviewed and upon motion of B. F. Milligan and seconded by L. C. Martin, ordered paid.

6. Upon motion of B. F. Milligan and seconded by L. C. Martin, delinquent taxes on personal property in the amount of \$726.62 were charged off the rolls as uncollectable. A list of these taxes are attached to and become a part of this minute.

All applications for Taxi Cab Permits were deferred for later meetings.

There was no further business presented, so the meeting adjourned.
