1 It was pointed out by Mr. Barly that if the City was to operate with the prese t forces and continued in the construction of the sewer lines and small water lines that it would be necessary to borrow twenty thousand (\$20,000.00) dollars to operate May and June or until a bond issue could be placed before the citizenship for approval.

After a brief discussion it was moved by D. M. Thrash and second by C. C. Sinclair that the Mayor and City Secretary be authorized to borrow in behalf of the City twenty thousand (\$20,000.00) dollars from the First State Bank & Trust Co. to be used for operating the City during May and June. The motion carried by unanimous vote of yea.

No further business was presented so the meeting adjourned.
