

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS HELD ON JULY 23, 1947
AT 7:30 P. M.

On this the twenty third day of July, 1947 A. D. the City Commissioners of the City of Lufkin, Texas met in a called meeting in the regular meeting place in the said City with the following members thereof, towit:

being present with D. M. Thrash-Commissioner- Ward 2, being absent thus constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted.

1. Minutes of all meetings held in June 1947 were read and approved.

1. June bills in the amount of \$ 9,449.65 (Nine thousand, four hundred forty-nine dollars and sixty-five cents) were reviewed and upon motion of L. C. Martin and second by C. C. Sinclair were approved for payment.

3. It was moved by C. C. Sinclair and second by G. W. Roland that Mr. Early be authorized to purchase one two ton GMAC truck and two three quarter ton studebaker pick up trucks or their equivalent to be used in construction. The motion carried by unanimous vote of yea.

4. A petition signed by resident property owners residing near a recent zone change as applied for by Mrs. Mellye Nissen requesting that the change be rescinded, was read, but no official action was taken on the matter.

5. It was then moved by C. C. Sinclair and second by G. W. Roland that South First Street be widened seven feet on each side from Burke Avenue to Denman Avenue and that it be of Concrete Construction with any surplus asphalt originally planed to be furnished by the state to be used on Ellis Avenue. The motion carried by unanimous vote of yea.

No further business was presented so the meeting adjourned.
