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MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION  
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD ON FEBRUARY 10,  
1947, AT 3:30 P. M.

On this, the tenth day of February, 1947, A. D., the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, met in a called meeting in the regular meeting place in said City with the following members, thereof, to-wit:

being present, with B. F. Milligan and E. A. Gibbs, Commissioners, being absent thus constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. This meeting was called for the purpose of public hearing on Zone change applications and applications for Taxi Cab permits. The first zone change application read was that of W. C. Dempsey to change a portion of district "F" to district "H". It was moved by D. M. Thrash and seconded by L. C. Martin to change the zone as requested. The motion carried by unanimous vote of yea.

2. The next application read was that of Mrs. K. Morgan for a change of a portion of district "A" to district "B". Several interested parties appeared before the council and stated their opinions, both for and against the change. After hearing all visitors, it was moved by L. C. Martin and seconded by D. M. Thrash that the Zone be changed for district "A" to district "B". The motion carried by unanimous vote of yea.

3. An application for zone change by D. O. Wallis was read, but action deferred until a later meeting.

4. January bills in the amount of \$15548.85 were reviewed and upon motion of L. C. Martin and seconded by D. M. Thrash, were ordered paid.

5. A letter from Dr. L. T. Tinkle, asking that the City sell him twenty feet off lot 9, block 4, of the Shearer Addition was read, but action on the matter was deferred for further investigation.

6. Motion was then made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by L. C. Martin to grant Braker Alexander two taxi cab permits and the Square Deal cab Co. two permits. The motion carried by unanimous vote of yea.

No further business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
