The following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Mr. Woodrow Scott, Representative of Land-of-Pines Dairy, and Mr. L. C. (Coop) Moore, and several other men representing KILD's Dairy, Tyler, Texas, were present in regard to an Amendment to Milk Ordinance pending. C. E. Brazil, City Attorney read proposed amendment, and after much discussion, Motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by C. C. Sinclair that rules be suspended and adopt same on First and final reading. The mayor put the motion to a vote. AYES, L. C. Martin, G. W. Roland, C. C. Sinclair. Mr. J. B. Early, read letter from Jno. S. Hedditt in regard to the Installation of Playground equipment on lots on Abney Avenue. L. C. Martin made motion that proposition be accepted. C. C. Sinclair seconded the motion. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted Aye. "Noes" None.

Mr. Early read letter from Koch & Fowler, Eng. Firm, Dallas, Texas, in regard to City awarding contract to various firms for Bid on Valves and etc. C. C. Sinclair made motion to accept bids. G. W. Roland seconded the motion. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "Noes" None.

Right-Of Way for the New Highway came up for discussion, and C. C. Sinclair made a motion to Pay Mrs. Fuller \$10,000.00 for Land and Damages only, or \$17,500 for Land, Improvements and Damages. L. C. Martin seconded the motion. The mayor put the motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "Noes" None.

5. A motion was made by L. C. Martin that Mr. D. A. Thrash, Commissioner Ward 2 be re-appointed Mayor Pro-Tem for the next two years. C. C. Sinclair seconded the Motion. The Mayor put the motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "Noes" None.

6. A motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by C. C. Sinclair, that Alley be closed running through Block No. 26 of the Derman Addition to The City of Lufkin, between Lots Numbers 1 and 2 on the North Side, and Lots Numbers 3 and 4 on the South. Mayor put the motion to a Vote. All voted "AYE". "Noes" None. (See copy of Resolution closing this Alley next page.)

7. A letter from Coy Ka tox requesting that City Grant him permit to operate two Taxi-cabs in the City of Lufkin. A Motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by G. W. Roland that permits be granted. Motion was put to a vote. All voted "AYE". "Noes" None.

8. A Letter from Glenn Gamble, requesting Permission to transfer of Taxi-Cab permit No. 80 to Roy Roberts. G. W. Roland made motion to transfer permit to Roy Roberts, and seconded by L. C. Martin. Motion put to a vote. All voted "Aye" "Noes" None.

9. C. T. Garrison made application for Zone Change on the N. 50 Ft. of Lots 1 and 2, of the North Montrose Addition from District "A" to District "K". A Motion was made by C. C. Sinclair and seconded by L. C. Martin that same be Published for a Public Hearing on June 9th, 1948, at 7:30 O'Clock P.M.. The Mayor put the motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "Noes" None.

10. A request of a zone change by C. M. Hicks and C. L. McFadden to change the zone from "E" District to "F" District on Lot No. 16, Block No. 7, of the North Lufkin, Addition to the City of Lufkin. Motion made by L. C. Martin and seconded by C. C. Sinclair that same be Published for a Public Hearing on June 9th, 1948, at 7:30 O'Clock P.M.. The Mayor put the motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "Noes" None.

11. Minutes of meetings held during the months of April and May were read, and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read.

12. An Amendment to a Certain Heating and Ventilating Ordinance was read, and L. C. Martin made motion that same be adopted on First and Second Reading. G. W. Roland seconded Motion. Mayor put motion to a vote all voted "AYE". "Noes" None.
