

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY

HELD ON JUNE 9th, A. D. 1948, 7:30 O'Clock

On this the 9th day of June, A. D. 1948, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, met in a called meeting in the "regular Meeting Place in said City with the following members, thereof-to-wit:

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:

1. The purpose of the meeting was to read and approve current bills due various parties and concerns, and to act on any other matter that might come before the Council.

2. Mr. Coy L. Wade, Sr., and Mr. W. B. Hutson, Citizens living beyond Glendale Cemetery, outside of City Limits, were present in regard to the low water pressure on the 2" line, and requesting that the City install a 6" main as far as the City Limits. The council assured them that they would try to remedy the situation.

3. A Motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by G. W. Roland, that Zone Change be granted B. L. Atkinson and C. J. McElroy from Zone "F" to Zone "H" on Lots 7 through 12 and Lots 1 & 2 of Block 2 in the Atkinson Addition to the City Of Lufkin, Texas, , same being advertised for public hearing for May 11th, A. D. 1948. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "Noes" None.

4. A Motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by G. W. Roland to approve Zone Change on the N. 50 Ft. of Lots 1 and 2 of the N. Montrose Addition to the City of Lufkin, from District "A" to District "F". Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "Noes" None. (Adv. 6-3-48)

5. A Motion was made by C. C. Sinclair and seconded by L. C. Martin to approve Zone Change of C. M. Hicks and O. L. McFaddin on Lot No. 16 Block 7 of the North Lufkin Addition from "E" District to "F" District. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "Noes" None. (Adv. 6-3-48).

Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved on first reading.

6. The above ordinance providing for the annual tax levy for the year 1948, was introduced for passage and approval on second and final reading. It was moved by D. M. Thrash and seconded by C. C. Sinclair that said ordinance be placed on second and final reading and that it pass second and final reading. The Mayor put the motion to a vote, and the following is the recorded vote on the motion. "AYES" L. C. Martin, G. W. Roland, G. Wright, C. C. Sinclair, D. M. Thrash. "NOES" NONE. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on second and final reading.

7. A Motion was made by G. W. Roland and seconded by C. C. Sinclair that application of Alec Andrews for Zone Change from Zone "A" to Zone "BW" of the SECOND ANDREWS ADDNT. to the City of Lufkin, Texas, be advertised for Public Hearing. All voted "AYE". "Noes" None.

8. A Motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by C. C. Sinclair that July 7th be proclaimed De Molay day, and that the young men would be in charge of the Affairs for that day. All Voted "AYE" Noes. "None".

9. A motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by C. C. Sinclair that James G. Clark be appointed to serve on CITY ZONING BOARD, All Voted "AYE". "Noes" None.

10. A motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by C. C. Sinclair that the 5 houses on Harmon Street that was purchased for Highway Right-of-way be advertised for sale to highest bidders. All voted "AYE" "Noes" None.

11. The current bills due various parties and concerns were read and discussed, and C. C. Sinclair made motion that same be allowed and paid. The Motion was seconded by D. M. Thrash. The mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "Aye" "Noes" None.

12. Application for Zone change on the Womack property came up for discussion, but since same did not conform to Zoning Rules and regulations it was not voted on.

13. There being no further business to come before the meeting, and on motion duly made and carried it adjourned.
