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2 The bids were opened and tabulated as follows: G. W. Young, bid \$3,210.00 for each house, E. -. Lelvin bid \$15,500.00 for five Houses, and Mr. A. E. Powell Bid \$10,060.55 for the 5 houses. After discussing the above bids, a hotion was made by L. J. Martin and seconded by L. M. Thrash, that City accept the bid of Mr. G. W. Young in the amount of \$16,050.00 for the five houses, city to pay their portion of taxes for first six months. The Mayor put motion to a vote.
