

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY

HELD ON JUNE 25th, A.D. 1948, 10:00 A.M.

On this the 25th day of June, A. D. 1948, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, met in a CALLED meeting in the Regular Meeting Place in said City with the following members, thereof-to-wit:

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1 The purpose of the meeting was to receive and open bids on the City's five (5) Houses on Harmon Street, and to act on any other matter that might come before the council.

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2 The bids were opened and tabulated as follows: G. W. Young, bid \$3,210.00 for each house, R. H. Melvin bid \$15,500.00 for five Houses, and Mr. A. E. Powell Bid \$10,060.55 for the 5 houses. After discussing the above bids, a Motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by D. M. Thrash, that City accept the bid of Mr. G. W. Young in the amount of \$16,050.00 for the five houses, city to pay their portion of taxes for first six months. The Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "Nocs" None.

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3 Mr. Early discussed the new 3/4" Tapping Charges in regard to some of the Plumbers Jobs, having already figured some of their on the old price of \$15.00. Council instructed City to get a list of Jobs in writing from each plumber that had made a commitment at the old price.

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4 There being no further business to come before the meeting, and on motion duly made and carried it adjourned.
