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The purpose of the meeting was to act on some Zoning matters, and to act on any other business that might come before the council.

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1. Robert Demm, R. L. Cunningham, and Rev. Allie Irick and several other property owners on Lufkin Avenue, appeared before the Council in regard to getting their portion of Street paved, and to find some way to help one of the property owners finance his part of the property. a solution was worked out agreeable to all concerned.

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2. Mr. Early recommended that City buy Tile from The Lazarene Church that they installed in ditch fronting Lufkin Avenue a year or two ago. Motion was made by J. C. Sinclair and seconded by G. W. Roland that City Buy the Tile for what it cost the Church. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AY" "Noes" None.

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3. A motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by D. M. Thrash to advertise for Publication, Application of C. C. Chambers, and J. O. Klein, for Zone Change of the Country Acn. to the City of Lufkin, from "B" District to "H" District for Public Hearing August 3rd, 1948, 7:30 O'Clock P.M.. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AY". "Noes" None.

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4. A motion was made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by L. C. Martin to Publish for Public Hearing, Zone Change for Ellie Strain on Lots No. 7 Block 2 of the Lunker Hill Acn. to the City of Lufkin, From District "A" to District "H", for public hearing August 3rd, 1948, 7:30 O'Clock P.M.. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AY" "Noes" None.

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5. A Motion was made by G. W. Roland and seconded by C. C. Sinclair to advertise for public hearing application of Mrs. J. O. Satterwhite for Zone Change on Lot No. 4, Block 3 of the Original Townsite to City of Lufkin, from "B" District to "H" District. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AY" "NOS" None.

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6. A motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by C. C. Sinclair to advertise for publication Zone Change Application of Will Scott, et ux, to change the zoning classification on lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 of the Martin Wagon Company Addition to the City of Lufkin, Texas, from District "B" to District "C". Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "NAYS" None.

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7. City Affairs in general were discussed. Mr. Early suggested that City Contract Frank Avenue Paving.

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8. A motion was made by D. L. Thrash and seconded by G. W. Roland that Resolution be passed authorizing the Mayor to execute a proper deed of Conveyance of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 of Block 2 of the Vinson Addition to the City of Lufkin, Texas, to Rosal Berwood Mooney. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "NAYS" None.

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9. There being no further business to come before the meeting, and on motion duly made and carried it adjourned.
