Brazil _____, City Attorney being present, and the following absent: none constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted: On a motion by Commissioner Zeagler, seconded by Commissioner Snell, the Council voted to set the selling price of the following City property as follows: Moore -----\$ 10,000.00 Pyle---- \$ 5,000.00 Fenley----\$ 15,000.00 (Sold separately: Land \$10,000.00 House 5,000.00) Floyd----\$ 4,000.00

It was agreed that these prices were subject to a revision, if a reasonable offer under anyone price set herewith was received. The properties are to be sold through Mr. Howard Walker, if possible.

- 2 The proposed resolution concerning the extension of existing water lines beyond the present city limits was discussed.
- Mr. Taylor B. Almon of Almon and McMahon, Inc., and City Engineer Joe McClendon, discussed with the Council the proposed construction of a sewage pump room and sump and the warrant financing of same.
