1940 AT 7:00 P. M.

constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1 On a motion by Commissioner Zeagler, seconded by Commissioner Snell,
the Council voted to set the selling price of the following City prop-
erty as follows:

Moore -----\$ 10,000.00

Pyle-----\$ 5,000.00

Fenley-----\$ 15,000.00

(Sold separately: Land \$10,000.00
House 5,000.00)

Floyd-----\$ 4,000.00

It was agreed that these prices were subject to a revision, if a
reasonable offer under anyone price set herewith was received. The
properties are to be sold through Mr. Howard Walker, if possible.


2 The proposed resolution concerning the extension of existing water
lines beyond the present city limits was discussed.

3 Mr. Taylor B. Almon of Almon and McMahan, Inc., and City Engineer Joe
McClendon, discussed with the Council the proposed construction of a
sewage pump room and sump and the warrant financing of same.

On motion by Commissioner Stegall, seconded by Commissioner Snell,
the council voted unanimously to adjourn.
