unanimously passed on motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by
Commissioner Zeagler.

2 Minutes of Council meeting of November 21, 1950, read and
unanimously approved on motion of Commissioner Zeagler, seconded by
Commissioner Snell.

3 Minutes of Council meeting of November 24, 1950, read and
unanimously approved on motion of Commissioner Treadwell, seconded by
Commissioner Zeagler.

4 Zone Change as requested by O. L. Cole given final unanimous
approval on motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by Commissioner
Treadwell.

5 Zone change as requested by Syl Vesta Berry given final un-
animous approval on motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by Com-
missioner Zeagler.

6 A resolution was read by City Attorney Brazil proposing the
abandonment by the City of Henry Street, between Chestnut Street and
Church Street, and the abandonment of an alley extending from Lee
Street to Grant Street, both in the Townsend Addition.

7 On motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by Commissioner
Zeagler, abandonment of the Alley was unanimously approved, the abandon-
ment of Henry Street was deferred.

Motion for adjournment by Commissioner Snell, seconded by
Commissioner Stegall, unanimously approved.
