

MINUTES OF Regular MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD February 16,
1950 AT 1:15 P.M.

On this the 16 day of February, A.D. 1950
the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in
special session, in the regular meeting place in said
City, with the following members thereof, to-wit:

being present, and the following absent: L. B. Zeagler, Com. Ward 3,
and R. A. Courtney, City Secretary.
constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. An ordinance providing for participation in the Texas Municipal
Retirement System by the City of Lufkin was passed and approved on
second and final reading. D. M. Thrash made motion that ordinance
be passed, seconded by Joe Stegall. All voted "aye."

2. Joe Stegall made motion that an election be called in the City
of Lufkin, Texas, at the time, place and manner as provided in the
Charter of said City, for the purpose of electing a Commissioner from
Ward No. Two and a Commissioner from Ward No. Four. Motion seconded
by L. C. Martin, All voted "aye."

3. An ordinance prohibiting the sale of all kinds of fire works within
the Fire Limits of the City of Lufkin was read. On first reading Joe
Stegall made motion that Ordinance be passed, Seconded by D. M. Thrash,
All voted "aye." Second reading D. M. Thrash made motion that Ordinance
be passed, seconded by L. C. Martin. All Voted "aye."

4. An ordinance amending paragraph one of Section Thirty Two "Examining
Board", of the Electrical Ordinance passed and approved by the City Com-
mission on the 11th day of June, A. D., 1935, was passed and approved
on the second and final reading, with D. M. Thrash making motion to
approve this Amendment, seconded by L. C. Martin. All voted "aye."

5. D. M. Thrash made a motion that Mayor Wright be authorized to sign
a resolution waiving the required set-back of twenty-five feet on the
east boundary line of Lots 9 and 10 in Block 2 of the Foundary Add.
Said east boundary line being the west boundary line of Barto Drive.
This would permit the erection of a proposed Filling Station Building
to be placed on the property line. Motion was seconded by Joe Stegall.
All voted "aye."

6. Commission placed a fee of \$25.00 on all permits for Carnivals
showing in the City of Lufkin. This fee to be placed on deposit by
the Sponsor of the Carnival, with a refund of this \$25.00 to be made
provided the Carnival grounds were left in a clean condition.

7. Mr. Early discussed the construction of small timber culverts for driveways on Highway 69 east. He was advised to use his own judgment in the placing of these culverts.

8. Mr. Early presented the current Bills for approval. All bills approved.

9. Commission approved the following charges for water Taps & Meters:
