constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1 The minutes of the regular meeting of August 5, 1951, were approved, motion of Commissioner Stegall, seconded by Commissioner Treadwell. The minutes of the Special meeting of August 14th, 1951 were approved on motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by Commissioner Stegall.

2 The City Manager reported on the better-than-average condition of Lufkin Cafes as graded by the State Food and Drug Inspector.

3 The Commission authorized the City Manager to proceed with the transfer and installation of traffic signals at Kurth and Junior High Schools.

4 Commissioner Snell made a motion, which Commissioner Stegall, seconded, that the Sewer Warrant Issue of \$19,000.00 be investigated as to availability for use, and that the issue be sold for improvements.

5 Commissioner Snell made a motion for the City Manager to make an immediate commitment for the purchase of a new FM police radio, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Stegall.

Motion to adjourn by Commissioner Stegall was seconded by Commissioner Snell.
