

MINUTES OF Regular MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD January 16th
1950 at 7:30 P. M.

On this the 16th day of January, A. D. 1951, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in Regular session, in the regular meeting place in said City, with the following members thereof, to wit:

being present, and the following absent: Joe Stegall

constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Contract for the construction of the North Side Lift Station was awarded to Murphy Brothers for \$7474.75, on motion of Commissioner Treadwell, seconded by Commissioner Zeagler.
2. The Council voted to pay the December, 1950, bills as presented, on motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by Commissioner Zeagler.
3. Minutes of the Council meeting of January 2, 1951, were approved on motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by Commissioner Treadwell.
4. Application for Zone change as presented by Ethel Hill was approved to be advertised, conditioned on approval of City Engineer, on motion of Commissioner Zeagler, seconded by Commissioner Treadwell.
5. Mr. Steenson reported on the progress of the Right-of-way procurement program for Highway #69.
6. The Council agreed to Mr. Steenson's recommendation that the City owned lot located South of the Welfare Office on Shepherd Avenue be rented to Mr. Kenneth E. Thompson for \$25.00 per month, on a 30 day trial basis, said lot to be used as a used car sales lot by Mr. Thompson.
7. The Council refused to sell any part of the approximately 100 acres located across the street from the new colored school, on petition of Robert Denum to buy.
8. Payment of one-half the cost of the Police barbecue was approved on motion of Commissioner Zeagler, seconded by Commissioner Snell.
9. On motion of Commissioner Zeagler, seconded by Commissioner Treadwell, the Council approved the sale for \$75.00 of a triangular section of land - in size, 33' across the base, with the other two sides approximately 245' and 230' - located in Lot 14, Block 2, Oak Grove Addition (See Attached drawing).

Adjournment voted on motion of Commissioner Zeagler, seconded by Commissioner Snell.
