constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1 Zone change as requested by Mrs. Jennie Rees Boykin, "B" District to "K" District, on the West 1/2 of Lot 2, of Block No. 61, Original Townsite of Lufkin, Texas, was approved to be advertised, on motion of Commissioner Zeagler, seconded by Commissioner Stegall.

2 Judge Brazil reported on the rejection of the zone change application as submitted on the Womack property.

3 A strip of property 100' x 76', necessary as right-of-way for the extension of Frank Street to Highway 94, owned by Mrs. J. E. Womack and J. C. Womack, was proposed for condemnation by resolution, on motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by Commissioner Zeagler. The Commissioners voted Aye.

4 A strip of property 100' x 76', necessary as right-of-way for the extension of Frank Street to Highway 94, owned by Mrs. Edwina Womack Collins, and husband Hal W. Collins, was proposed for condemnation by resolution, on motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by Commissioner Zeagler. The Commissioners voted Aye.

5 A strip of property 100' x 76', necessary as right-of-way for the extension of Frank Street to Highway 94, owned by Mrs. Margaret Bryce, and husband W. D. Bryce, was proposed for condemnation by resolution, on motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by Commissioner Zeagler. The Commissioners voted Aye.

6 On motion of Commissioner Zeagler, seconded by Commissioner Snell, the bills for the month, as submitted, were approved for payment.

7 The budget for the fiscal year 1951-1952 was approved, as presented, on motion of Commissioner Stegall, seconded by Commissioner Treadwell.

The Commissioners voted to adjourn on motion of Commissioner Stegall, seconded by Commissioner Snell.
